

Snack Policy

Addlestone Pre-School will not provide snack during this time (June/July 2020). Children must bring their own drink and snack items in a suitable container.

Snack time process

- **The snack table(s) will be cleaned by an adult using a blue cloth and anti-bacterial spray.**
- **An adult will place name cards on table(s).**
- **Snack time will be announced by an adult and children will be asked to wash their hands (under adult supervision) and find their table (with adult help).**
- **Children will retrieve their snack from their bags and sit back at their table. Adults will supervise children, but where possible they should be able to access and eat their snack independently as they get used to Preschool's routine. Snacks should be nutritious (eg. fruit, cereal bar, squeeze yoghurt) and not contain nuts. They should be ready to eat and chopped if required to avoid handling by anyone other than the child it belongs to.**
- Once children have finished their drink and snack, they will be encouraged to put their rubbish in the bin, which is emptied on a regular basis by the designated member of staff.
- The table will be cleaned again using anti-bacterial spray after the children have finished their snack.
- When the children go out to play toilet seats will be cleaned with disposable anti-bacterial wipes. Clean wash basins, mop floor, flush toilets, make sure paper towel dispenser is full and generally leave in a clean state ready for the next session.
- Wipe Kitchen surfaces and leave in a clean and tidy state ready for the next session.

- Sweep the floor in main area, and steam clean.
- Empty all rubbish bins at the end of each session and where necessary throughout the day.
- Pre-school is thoroughly cleaned, after each session by the designated member of staff.
